Biography





Mary-Anne was born in England and studied art in Portsmouth and Bristol. She was awarded a Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree (Honours). After exhibiting and teaching in London she moved to Australia in 1982 and immersed herself in the Australian art scene. She became a portrait tutor and councillor for the Royal Queensland Art Society, also running various workshops for established art groups including the Pastel Society of Australia, and was frequently invited to judge art competitions.

Moving to Melbourne in 2003 to support her youngest son, Jared, who received a place at the Australian Ballet School, she set up her own gallery and continued to exhibit and teach. Mary-Anne currently has a studio outside of Melbourne near Ballarat as well as a studio in Aveyron in the south of France.

Mary-Anne is an award winning artist and has won many accolades in Australia. Her art is held in both private as well as public collections in the UK, Australia, Canada, India, USA and Japan.

Mary-Anne's skills and talent as a portrait artist has resulted in high profile commissions from institutions, including the Deans and Presidents from Kings College, Sydney, the University of Queensland and the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners respectively. Also a portrait of the late Queen Mother was commissioned for the Royal Marine Barracks in Portsmouth, England.

Her youngest son Jared Rainford Wright is a professional dancer with the Dutch National Ballet in Amsterdam, having previously been a company member of the Australian Ballet. Originally Jared was to perform at the opening of this exhibition but unfortunately his schedule performing principal roles in Carmen and Paquita in Amsterdam have precluded his physical presence.

Jared has however choreographed a piece which he performs with Amanda McGuigan (also of the Dutch National Ballet), which will be premiered at the opening of the exhibition by video. It can also be viewed online via the link on www.wrightvanross.com








Limited Edition Prints
